### Community Resilience Plan

A Parish resilience plan will describe what we will do as a community during emergencies. It will identify the risks we may have to deal with and the probable impact they may cause such as severe and prolonged snow.

It will also include details of other organisations that can be contacted in an emergency, such as the emergency services, utilities or County Council as well as those responses we can provide from within the Parish itself.

<i>Flood (incl Surface water)</i>	<i>Property damage, loss of utilities, contamination &amp; disease risk</i>	<i>Congestion, road closures, flooding to properties; potential homelessness</i>	<i>Provide practical support; share EA &amp; FODDC info; contact STW; liaise with FOD Housing Team</i>
<i>Sustained power outage</i>	<i>Loss of heating, lighting, communication, refrigeration</i>	<i>Disruption to amenities &amp; local businesses Vulnerable residents unable to gain access to supplies or medication</i>	<i>Report to national grid, identify community safe space, check on known vulnerable residents</i>
<i>Severe weather (Storms, heavy snow, freezing conditions, heatwave, high winds)</i>	<i>Fallen trees, building or vehicle damage, public accidents, icy roads, heat related illness</i>	<i>Congestion, power outages, gridlock, school/work disruption, limited care services</i>	<i>Issue sandbags, open community buildings, identify volunteers to visit known isolated &amp; vulnerable; communicate updates to public</i>
<i>Road accidents</i>	<i>Traffic diversions, blocked routes</i>	<i>Care services delayed, community access disrupted</i>	<i>Support traffic management, share diversion information, coordinate with emergency services</i>
